

Fury

Type

24-gun sixth-rate frigate. Built to the twenty-gun sixth-rate sloop establishment of 1741 but now mounting twenty 9 pdr on the upper deck and four 9 pdr on the gun deck

Complement

Total complement 160: captain, lieutenant, master, bosun, gunner, carpenter, surgeon, purser, 2 master's mates, 4 midshipmen, marine lieutenant, marine sergeant, marine corporal, 35 marine privates

Armament

20 x 9 pdr on the upper deck, 4 x 9 pdr on the gun deck, 4 x 6 pdr on the quarterdeck

Dimensions

112ft 6in on the gundeck, 32ft 3in beam, 11ft 10in depth in the hold, 514 tons (builder's measurement).

Rig

Conventional ship rig of the period with a half-lateen mizzen and no royals.

Boats

Pinnace and cutter
